



S-134 Safety on the Fireline (CIFFC)

Overview/Description

This online course aims to educate employees on how to avoid incidents on the fireline. This course is essential to anyone working on the fireline to ensure fireline personnel are aware of hazards and their associated risks. Safety is a major consideration in preventing wildland fire accidents.
