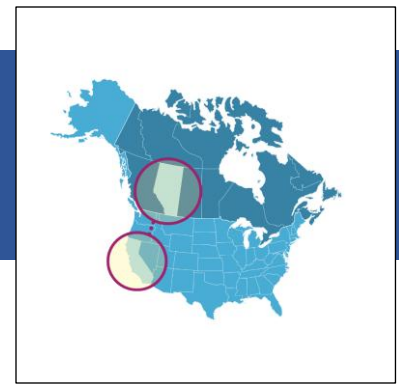


## California and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

- Alberta is California's 26<sup>th</sup> largest trading partner

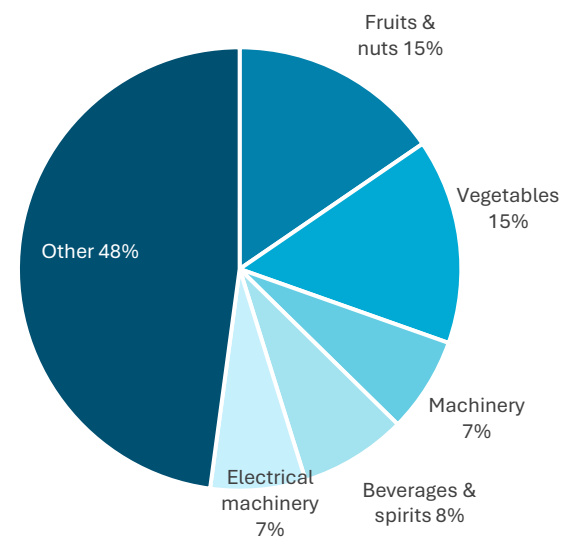
### California – Alberta Trade \$USD

- Bilateral trade: **\$4.7 billion**
- California exports to Alberta: **\$1.5 billion**
- California imports from Alberta: **\$3.2 billion**

### California's Top Exports to Alberta \$USD

- Fruits & nuts: **\$231.7 million**
- Vegetables: **\$224.5 million**
- Machinery: **\$142.2 million**
- Beverages & spirits: **\$117.4 million**
- Electrical machinery: **\$104.2 million**

### Alberta Snapshot

Capital Power, an Alberta independent power producer, owns and operates the La Paloma Generating Facility in Kern County, California. This 1,062 MW combined-cycle natural gas power plant was acquired by Capital Power in February 2024.

The facility plays a crucial role in supporting the reliability of California's electricity grid. It has resource adequacy contracts in place through 2029 with multiple investment-grade utilities and load-serving entities, ensuring a stable supply of electricity to meet the state's energy demands.
