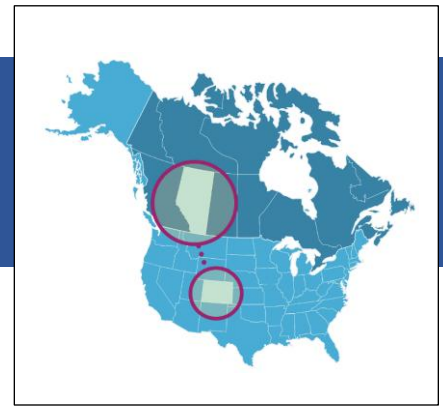


## Colorado and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

- Alberta is Colorado's largest trading partner



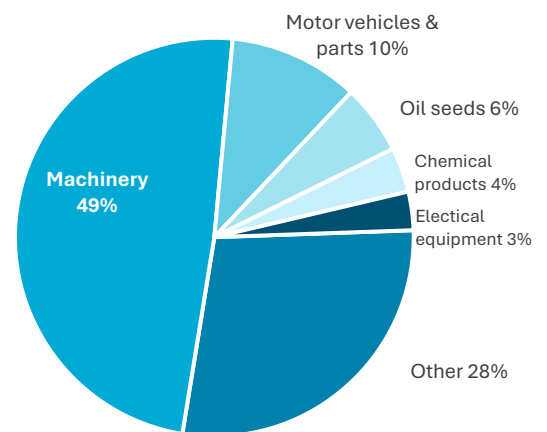
### Colorado – Alberta Trade \$USD

- Machinery: **\$134.8 million**
- Motor vehicles & parts: **\$29.1 million**
- Oil seeds: **\$15.6 million**

### Alberta Snapshot

The expansion aims to improve water reliability for over 1.5 million residents, ensuring water security and supporting economic stability in the region.
