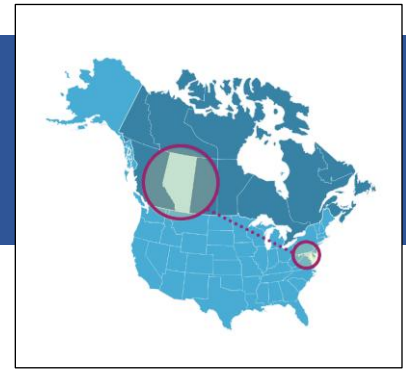


## Maryland and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

- **904,000** U.S. jobs are supported by trade with Alberta



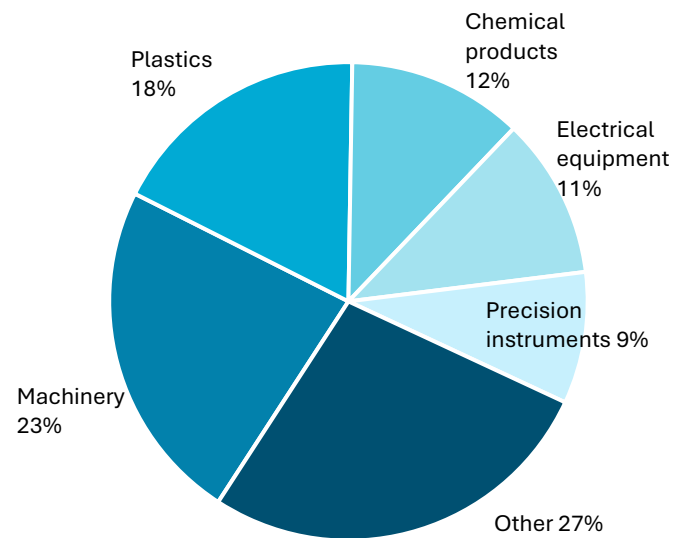
### Maryland – Alberta Trade \$USD

- Bilateral trade: **\$100.8 million**
- Maryland exports to Alberta: **\$20.2 million**
- Maryland imports from Alberta: **\$80.6 million**

### Maryland’s Top Exports to Alberta \$USD

- Machinery: **\$4.7 million**
- Plastics: **\$3.6 million**
- Chemical products: **\$2.4 million**
- Electrical equipment: **\$2.2 million**
- Precision instruments: **\$1.8 million**
