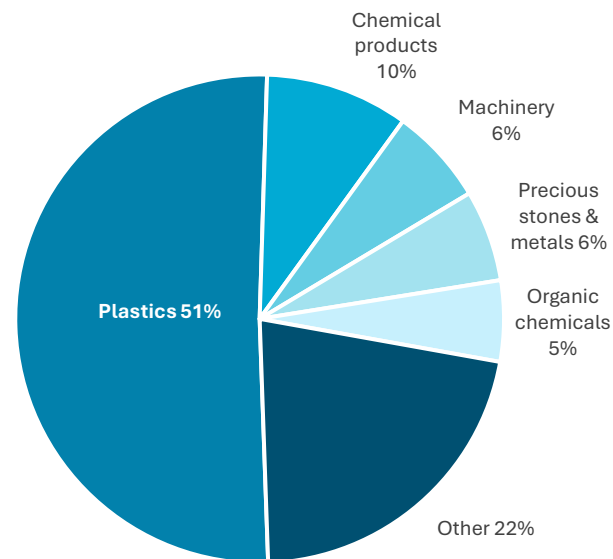
New Jersey – Alberta Trade \$USD

Alberta Snapshot

Alberta is the number one supplier of oil and gas to the United States and plays an integral role in North American energy security. Calgary, Alberta-based Enbridge, a multi-national pipeline and energy company, moves about 30% of the crude oil produced in North America, transports nearly 20% of the natural gas consumed in the U.S., and operates North America's largest natural gas utility by volume.

Enbridge's Algonquin Gas Transmission pipeline transports 3.09 billion cubic feet of natural gas per day through its 1,131 miles long pipeline system. Running through New Jersey and connecting with the Texas Eastern Transmission and the Maritimes & Northeast pipelines, the Algonquin Gas Transmission Pipeline enables Enbridge to offer abundant and reliable natural gas at a competitive rate.
