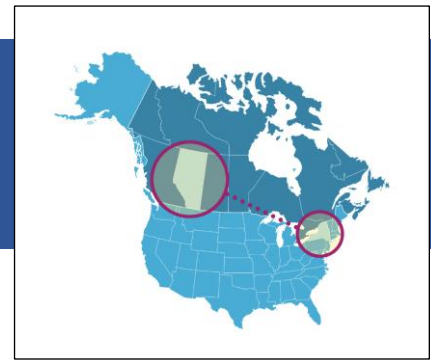


## New York and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

- **904,000** U.S. jobs are supported by trade with Alberta



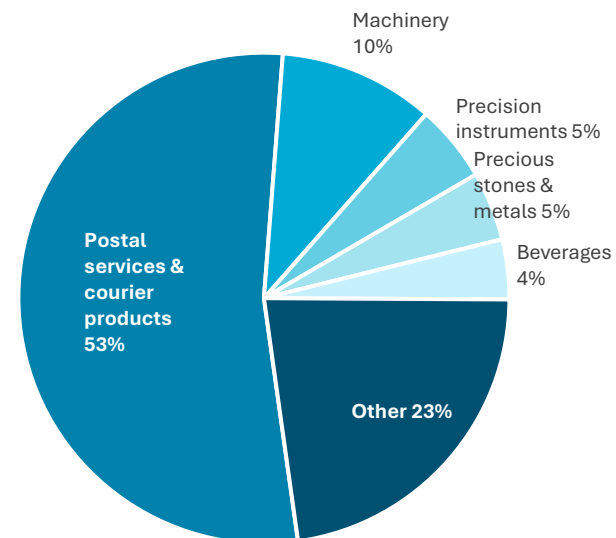
### New York – Alberta Trade \$USD

## Alberta Snapshot

Stantec, a global design and engineering firm headquartered in Edmonton, Alberta, has a significant presence in New York. With six offices in Albany, Binghamton, Buffalo, Hauppauge, New York City, and Rochester, Stantec is contributing to the state's economy through job creation and infrastructure development.

The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey selected Stantec to lead preliminary and final design work for the maintenance and control facility as a part of the planned AirTrain Newark replacement project.
