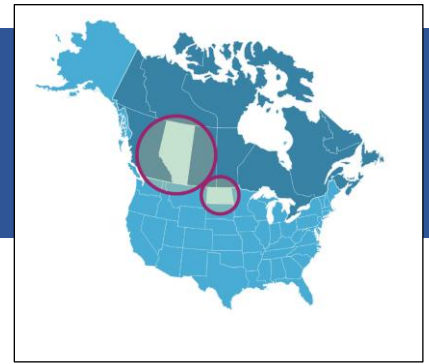


## North Dakota and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

- Alberta is North Dakota's largest trading partner

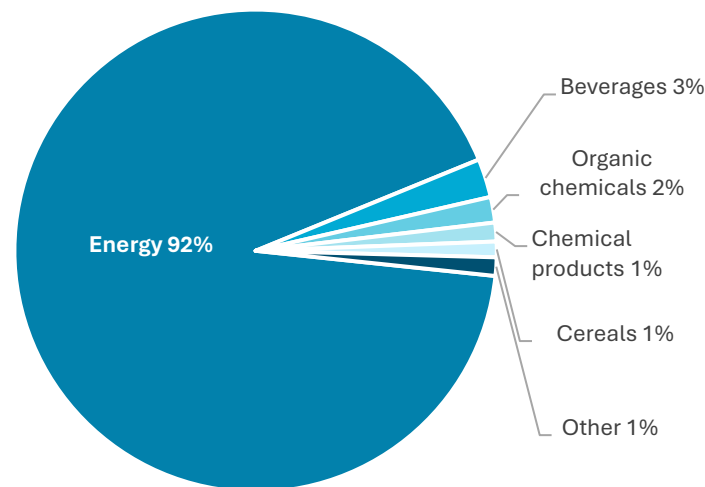
### North Dakota – Alberta Trade \$USD

- Beverages: **\$132 million**

## Alberta Snapshot

Calgary, Alberta-based Pembina Pipeline Corporation is a leading transportation and midstream service provider serving North America's energy industry for 70 years.

Pembina owns the Alliance Pipeline, a 2,391-mile integrated Canadian and U.S. natural gas transmission system delivering rich natural gas from the Western Canadian Sedimentary Basin and the Williston Basin to the Chicago market hub.

The United States portion of the system consists of approximately 967 miles of infrastructure including the 80-mile Tioga Lateral in North Dakota, which has been in commercial service since December 2000. Through an innovative suite of customer-focused services, it delivers an average of 1.6 billion standard cubic feet of natural gas per day, creating new economic value for producers, shippers, and third-party market participants.
