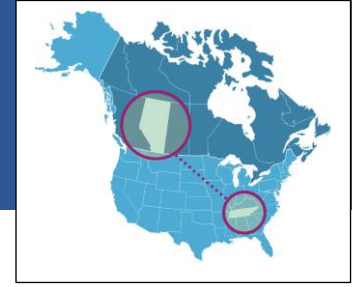


# Tennessee and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

- **904,000** U.S. jobs are supported by trade with Alberta

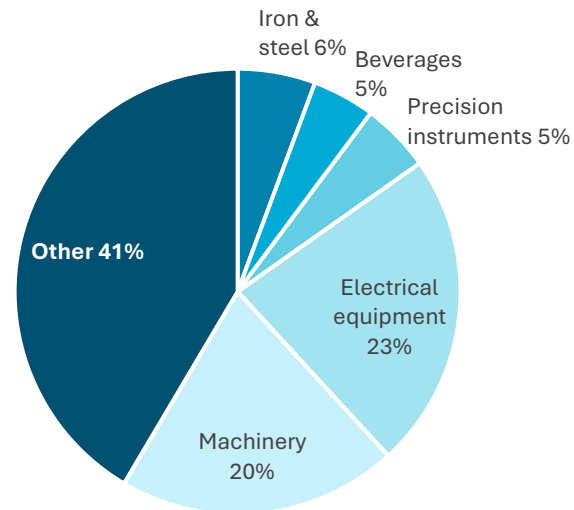
## Tennessee – Alberta Trade \$USD

- Bilateral trade: **\$356.2 million**
- Tennessee exports to Alberta: **\$145.1 million**
- Tennessee imports from Alberta: **\$211.1 million**

## Tennessee’s Top Exports to Alberta \$USD

- Electrical equipment: **\$33.3 million**
- Machinery: **\$29.5 million**
- Iron & steel: **\$8.2 million**
- Precision instruments: **\$7.3 million**
- Beverages: **\$6.6 million**

## Alberta Snapshot

Both Alberta and Tennessee are known for their natural beauty and outdoor recreation. Alberta has the Rocky Mountains and national parks like Banff and Jasper, while Tennessee is home to the Smoky Mountains.

Calgary-based airline WestJet now operates non-stop flights from Edmonton and Calgary to Nashville with an average flight time of about three hours and 50 minutes.
