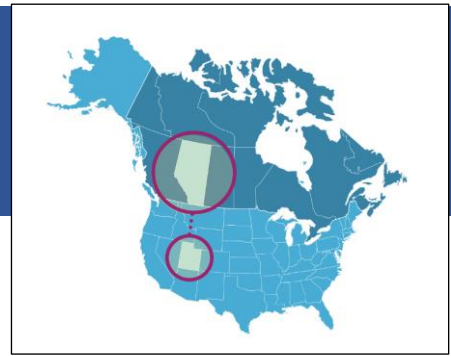


## Utah and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

- Alberta is Utah's 6<sup>th</sup> largest trading partner

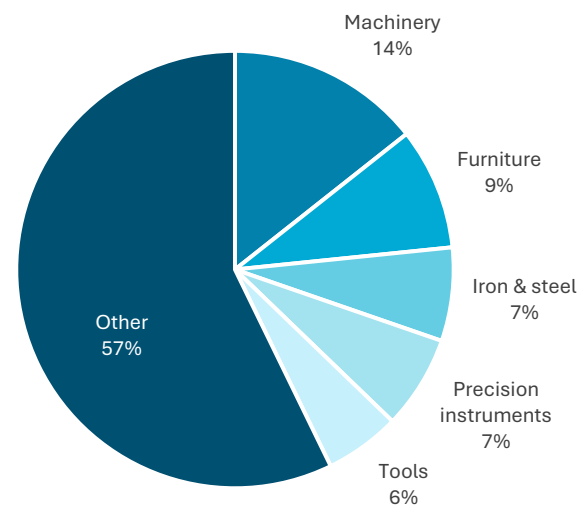
### Utah – Alberta Trade \$USD

## Alberta Snapshot
