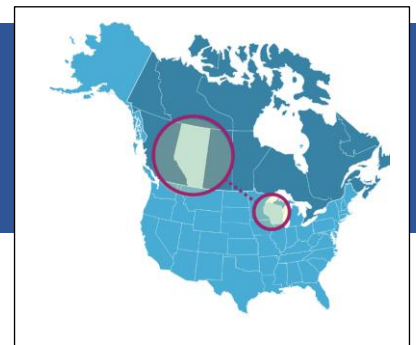


## Wisconsin and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

- Alberta is Wisconsin's 17<sup>th</sup> largest trading partner

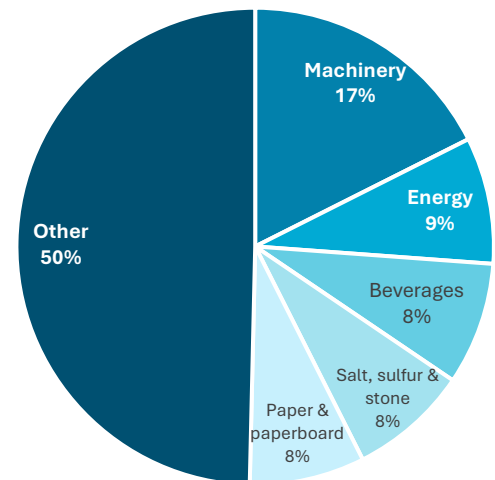
### Wisconsin – Alberta Trade \$USD

- Bilateral trade: **\$1 billion**
- Wisconsin exports to Alberta: **\$219 million**
- Wisconsin imports from Alberta: **\$788.9 million**

### Wisconsin's Top Exports to Alberta \$USD

- Machinery: **\$38.5 million**
- Energy: **\$18.8 million**
- Beverages: **\$18.2 million**
- Salt, sulfur & stone: **\$17.7 million**
- Paper & paperboard: **\$17.1 million**

### Alberta Snapshot

Alberta is the number one supplier of oil and gas into the United States and plays an integral role in North American energy security. The ANR Pipeline was first founded as the Michigan-Wisconsin Pipe Line Company in 1945. It is now owned and operated by TC Energy headquartered in Calgary, Alberta.

ANR is one of the largest interstate natural gas pipeline systems in the United States with approximately 9,000 miles of pipeline and delivers more than one trillion cubic feet of natural gas annually.

With the ability to tap virtually all of the major gas supply basins in North America, ANR serves customers throughout Wisconsin and the Midwest.
