<p>Job offer in a regulated occupation in Alberta and holds certification or licensing demonstrating meets regulatory requirements to practice the occupation in Alberta</p> <p>Some professional occupations and designated occupations and trades are regulated occupations in Alberta. Professional occupations are regulated by professional regulatory bodies and designated trades and occupations are regulated by Alberta Apprenticeship and Industry Training (AIT).</p> <p>Only those who have an Alberta job offer in a regulated occupation and have a recognized certification or licensure from the professional regulatory body responsible for the occupation in Alberta will be awarded points.</p> <p>Claiming Points for Regulated Trades under the AAIP</p> <p>To claim the 10 points for working in a regulated occupation on your AAIP Worker Expression of Interest (WEOI) application, you must hold one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A valid Alberta Qualification Certificate, or A trade certificate recognized by Alberta Apprenticeship and Industry Training (AIT). <p>All designated or regulated trades are eligible to claim the 10 points for working in a regulated occupation, as long as the individual holds one of these certificates.</p> <p>If certification is not compulsory in your occupation and you do not have a trade certificate, you cannot claim points under regulated occupation.</p>	Maximum Points: 10

The AAIP also collects the following information in the Worker EOI to support selection for draws to meet sector labour needs and other program priorities. The AAIP does not award points for these factors:

- Status with Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (work permit status and federal Express Entry profile information)
- **National Occupational Classification (NOC) code (2021 version)** of your Alberta Job offer occupation
- Primary line of business of your Alberta job offer employer identified using a **4 digit North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code (2022 version)**
